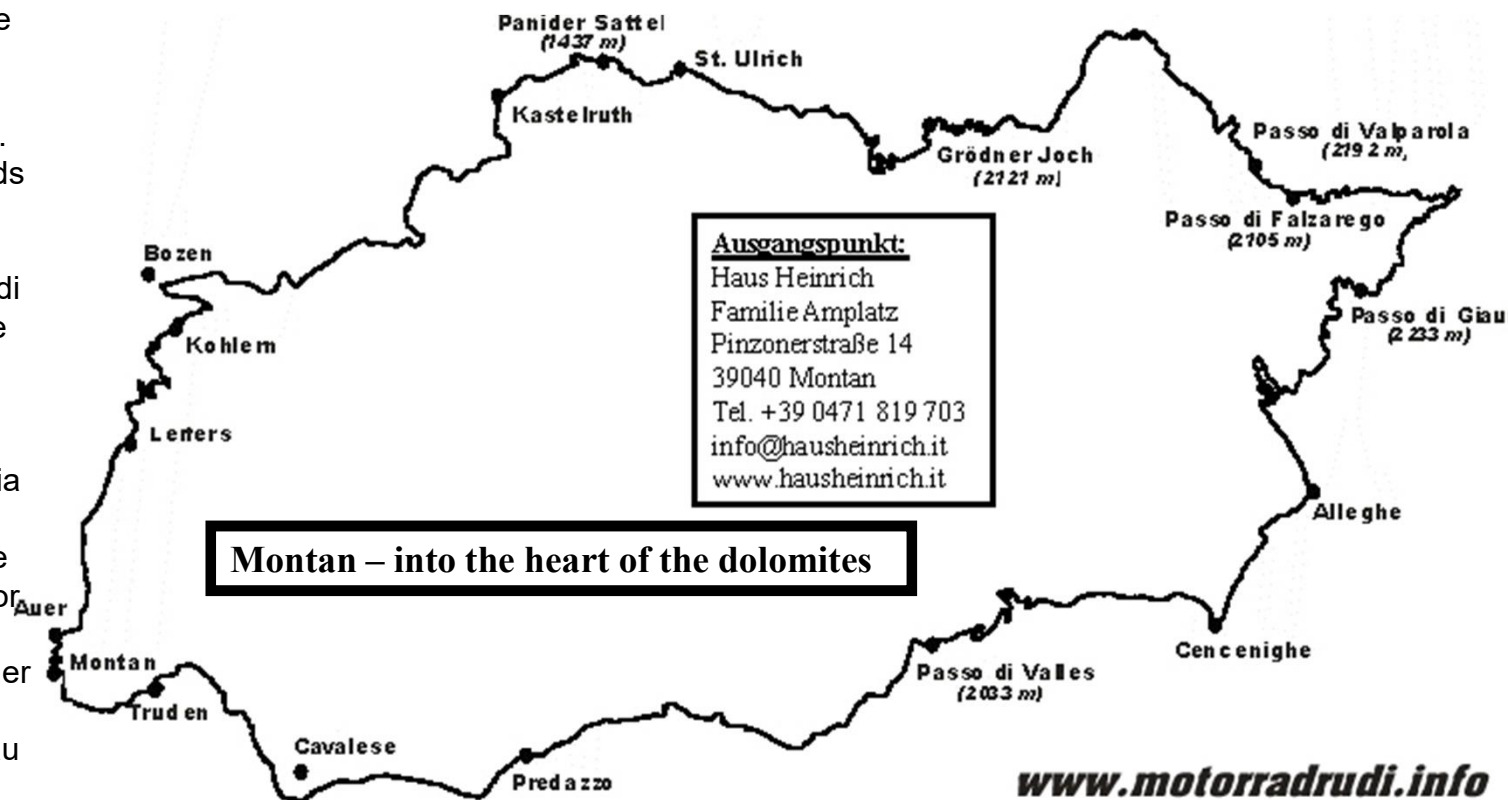


Route description/characteristics

5 passes with more than 2000 m altitude are waiting for us, in addition curves, bends, curves ... and one picture book landscape after the other. Seen from Montan, the route leads to the northeastern area. The roads are - with the exception of the turnoff to Kohlern (from Bozen) - wide and well developed.

From Montan the route leads via Truden to Kaltenbrunn, past Cavalese to Predazzo. There turn right towards Passo di Rolle. After about 15 km, the trail turns left up to Passo di Valles (2033 m). At the end of the pass road turn right towards Cencenighe. In Cencenighe turn left via Aleghe to Caprile. Turning right there, the further way leads up for 6 km. Then turn right again, until after another 7 km you reach the turnoff to Passo di Giau (2233 m). Go up there and then down again on

the other side and turn left to Passo di Falzarego (2105 m). At the top of the pass, turn right up to Passo di Valparola (2192 m) and continue via St. Kassian to La Villa/Stern. There turn left to Corvara. Here it goes right up to the Grödner Joch (2121 m). After the descent turn right into the Grödner valley. We stay in the valley until Ortisei and then turn left to reach Castelfratto via the Panider Sattel (1437 m). We stay on this road and continue via Seis and Völz am Schlern to Bozen. Shortly after entering Bolzano (roundabout) the road to Colle/Kohlern branches off to the left. This narrow but well asphalted road leads steeply uphill and offers great views down to the Eisack valley and Bolzano. Further up the road leads past Colle/Kohlern. At the end of the road we first turn left to reach an inn at the end of the track, which invites you to stay. From here, without turning off into the valley, we descend to the N12, which leads via Leifers (Laives) to Auer (Ora). Turn left there and after 6 km you will reach Montan again.
